FRIENDS OF HONDURAN CHILDREN - Under-funded and ill-equipped, the poor state of Honduras' education system and high cost of sending a child to school has resulted in a shocking illiteracy rate of 24%. Many children don't make it past primary school if they make it to school at all. Thanks to the generosity of donors, Honduran young people are getting the chance to become self-sufficient through a combination of practical training and academic study. In addition to supporting existing education efforts offered to children in the care of Sociedad Amigos de los Ninos, the Friends of Honduran Children Education & Scholarship initiative provides school supplies to rural primary schools and is developing scholarships that will enable students to pursue vocational training at the high school level.
